The church is listed under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

At a meeting of the Diocesan Advisory Committee held on 08/02/2021

The following works or other proposals were considered:

Extension to existing Coffee Corner servery counter to provide improved service and to enhance health and safety requirements. The extension will facilitate welcoming of visitors and improve facilities for meetings of various sorts within the church.

The removal of pews up to the centre aisle to meet the growing missional demands placed on the church.

Creation of a small kitchenette for staff use only, to be located in now redundant toilets in the choir vestry which is available only to members of staff and approved volunteers.

In the opinion of the Committee the work or part of the work proposed is likely to affect -

To install permanently a live-streaming system with enhanced sound, permanently move the camera to a position which does not affect the character of the church as a building of special architectural or historic interest which is a Grade II listed building. Relocate the sound desk as specified in submitted forms which will not affect the lines of site from the desk and improve the current aesthetically unsympathetic cable run system. The camera system was installed in July and approved as a temporary measure with Archdeacon's approval. The archaeological importance of the church is seen in:
