Key areas of responsibility include:

- supporting our Sunday ministry to children who stay in for services, helping the vicar to engage and involve them, and encouraging children to participate fully in this key area of our church life together
- leading (and potentially, preaching at) at Sunday services
- running a midweek Bible study group for children (including recruiting and leading a team)
- looking out for families on Sundays, and supporting them in discipling their children
- leading weekly collective worship (assemblies) at St. George's C of E Primary Academy
- running an evangelistic toddler group (including recruiting and leading a team)
- outreach amongst children and families (e.g. holiday clubs, Light Party, etc)

It is essential for the person to have demonstrable experience of working with children, as well as good interpersonal and communication skills. Good technological skills, including the use of social media would be desirable.

Safeguarding is integral to the Church's work. As such, an enhanced DBS check will be required.

This post also has a genuine occupational requirement to be filled by a committed Christian who will affirm the C of E's long-standing teaching on marriage as set out in Canon B30.
